

God's Promise of Deliverance  
Lesson #5  
Exodus 5:22-7:7

Pharaoh had responded to the request of the LORD God of Israel with *"Who is the LORD? I do not know the LORD and I will not let Israel go."* (Exodus 5:2) As a result of that request, Pharaoh would no longer provide straw for the bricks. From that day on, the Israelites could gather their own straw. However, Pharaoh was very clear that he still expected them to meet the daily quota of bricks. The Israelite foremen blamed Moses and Aaron for this hardship. They informed Moses and Aaron that they have become a stench to Pharaoh and his officials and they want to kill us.
