**Consecration of the Priests - Exodus 29:1-9**

1. What animals were required to be offered up in consecration for the priests? (Exodus 29:1)
  
2. What grain offering was to be included with this? (Exodus 29:2)
  
3. Aaron and his sons were to come to the entrance of the Tent of Meeting. What would take place there?

4. What was not to be done for Aaron's sons? (Exodus 29:8a)
  - How long were Aaron and his descendants to be priests to the LORD? (Exodus 29:9)

**The Consecration Offerings - Exodus 29:10-34**

5. The first offering was the bull. What was this offering for? (Exodus 29:14b)
  
6. How was this offering to be made?
  - The location: (Exodus 29:10a)

12. What was to be done with the bread and cake that accompanied this second ram?

13. What was unique about this ram's breast? (Exodus 29:26)
  
14. In addition to the breast, what else was included as belonging to Aaron? (Exodus 29:27)
  
15. This was called the fellowship offering because it was eaten in the presence of the LORD. Where was it to be:

- Cooked? (Exodus 29:31)
- Eaten (Exodus 29:32)

16. What made this possible? (Exodus 29:33a)

- Was anyone else allowed to eat this ram? (Exodus 29:33b)

17. What was to be done with any leftovers? (Exodus 29:34)

18. How long would the consecration process take? (Exodus 29:35)

19. In addition to the three consecration offerings, what animals were to be offered each day? (Exodus 29:38)

20. Why did the LORD call the Tabernacle the Tent of Meeting? (Exodus 29:42, 43)

21. At the completion of the consecration process what would be the result? (Exodus 29:44, 45)

**Final Instructions - Exodus 30:11-38 and 31:12-18**

23. Each time a census was taken in Israel, what must each person do? (Exodus 30:11-12)

25. Who was required to pay? (Exodus 30:14)
  
26. What was the purpose for this? (Exodus 30:15)
  - Define the word “Atone”
  
27. How was this money to be used? (Exodus 30:16a)
  
28. Aaron and his sons were instructed to wash their hands and feet before serving the LORD. What was to be made for this washing? (Exodus 30:18a)
  - Where was this to be located? (Exodus 30:18b)
  
29. How serious did the LORD expect them to obey all His instructions? (Exodus 30:20, 21)
  
30. Sacred oil was to be created by a perfumer for the purpose of anointing. What five items were in this oil? (Exodus 30:22–24)
  
31. Once this was made, what items were to be anointed first? (Exodus 30:26–28)
  - After these items were anointed, what were they considered? (Exodus 30:29)
  
32. Following the anointing of these items, Aaron and his sons were to be anointed. Could this oil be used by anyone or anything else? (Exodus 30:32)
  
33. The final instruction was for the sacred blend of incense to be used in front of the Tent of Meeting. What was the method used to prepared these five spices? (Exodus 30:35b, 36a)

34. The Covenant had been agreed to by the people and sealed in blood. What was the sign of this covenant? (Exodus 31:13)
  
35. How was it to be observed? (Exodus 31:15)
  
36. Why did the LORD choose this as the sign? (Exodus 31:17)
  
37. When the LORD had finished telling Moses all His instruction, what was Moses given? (Exodus 31:18)
