4.	Jesus then asked them directly, "But who do you say that I am?" Simon Peter spoke up first. What was Peter's answer to this question according to each of the Gospels? • Luke 9:20

5.	What was Jesus' surprising reaction to Peter's declaration? (Luke 9:21)

6. Up to this point, life with Jesus had been very exciting! The disciples were convinced Jesus was the Messiah – the Christ, the promised savior of Israel. Now things got confusing. Jesus was saying things they did not understand or want to hear. Summarize what Jesus told his disciples right after Peter's declaration. (Luke 9:22)

7. How did Peter react to what Jesus said? (Matthew 16:22)

- 9. All of a sudden the cost of discipleship changed radically! What did Jesus say it would cost his disciples to follow him?
