

9. The next day, before anyone knew what Ishmael had done, another story is recorded. What happened that day? (Jeremiah 41:4-9)

10. What else did Ishmael do? (Jeremiah 41:10)

11. The plot thickens as the story continues. What did Johanan do when he heard what had happened? (Jeremiah 41:11-14)

12. Now it's Ishmael's turn to flee. Where did he and his eight remaining men go? (Jeremiah 41:15)

13. Meanwhile, what was happening back in Judah? (2 Kings 25:26)

14. Jeremiah gave more details about this event in his book. Who was the leader and organizer of this remnant group? (Jeremiah 41:16)

15. Before they left, they made one stop. Where did they stop and why? (Jeremiah 41:17 - 42:3)

16. How did Jeremiah the prophet reply to them? (Jeremiah 42:4)

17. At this point it appears that we are seeing what was really in the “heart” of these people. What did they say and do? (Jeremiah 42:5,6)

18. How long did it take for Jeremiah to get an answer? (Jeremiah 42:7)

19. Why do you think it took that long?

20. Once he had the Lord’s answer, Jeremiah called together Johanan, all the army officers and all the people and said, *“This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, to whom you sent me to present your petition says....”* What was the message? (Jeremiah 42:10-17)

21. He continued on with God’s warning. What did he say in Jeremiah 42:18?

22. The word of the Lord was complete at this point, but Jeremiah had some words of his own to add. This time we do see the “heart” of this faithful prophet of the Lord as he spoke to the people on his own behalf. What tone of voice do you think he used and what did he say? (Jeremiah 42:19-22)

23. *“When Jeremiah finished telling the people all the words of the Lord their God – everything the Lord had sent him to tell them,”* what happened? (Jeremiah 43:2, 3)

24. Under the leadership of Johanan, what did *“all the people”* choose to do? (Jeremiah 43:4-7)

25. When they arrive just inside the border of Egypt at the city of Tahpanhes, the Lord spoke to Jeremiah again. What message did He give this time? (Jeremiah 43: 8-13)

26. Jeremiah's ministry to the people who went into self-exile in Egypt concluded with one final message from the Lord. Who was the message for? (Jeremiah 44:1)

27. What name did Jeremiah use for the Lord? (Jeremiah 44:2)

28. After once again recounting to them why Judah had fallen to the Babylonians, he pleaded with them not let it happen again. What did he say in Jeremiah 44:7-10?

29. He continued on: *"None of the remnant of Judah who have gone to live in Egypt will escape or survive to return to the land of Judah, to which they long to return and live; none will return except a few fugitives."* Who answered him and what did they say? (Jeremiah 44:15-18)

30. What group spoke up next and what did they say? (Jeremiah 44:19)

31. What did Jeremiah say to them? (Jeremiah 44:20-23)

32. Jeremiah delivered his final recorded message to the remnant in Egypt. What did he say they were doing? (Jeremiah 44:24-25)

33. After saying, *"Go ahead then, do what you promised! Keep your vows!"* the Lord took a vow in His own name, one that surely would be fulfilled. What was that vow? (Jeremiah 44:26)

34. What did the Lord say in 27a?

35. What sign did the Lord say He would give so they would know His word is true? (Jeremiah 44:30)

36. With what prophetic words did Jeremiah leave the remnant in Egypt? (Jeremiah 44:28)
