 - As soon as Paul got off the ship in Tyre, what did he do?

 - How long did Paul stay in Tyre?

 - What was Paul told while in Tyre?

5. How did Paul respond to their urging? (Acts 21:5a)

6. What note did Luke add about their departure? (Acts 21:5b-6)

7. From Tyre they went to Ptolemais. What did Luke say about Ptolemais? (Acts 21:7)

Caesarea – Acts 21:8-16

8. What did Luke record about their time in Caesarea? (Acts 21:8, 9)

9. The team stayed there for a while, long enough for a prophet name Agabus to arrive.
 - Where was Agabus from? (Acts 21:10)

 - What did Agabus do? (Acts 21:11a)

 - What did he say? (Acts 21:11b)

10. Was this new information to Paul? (Acts 20:22, 23)

11. How did Paul's team and the Believers in Caesarea react to this news? (Acts 21:12)

12. What was Paul's answer to their concern? (Acts 21:13)

13. When they couldn't persuade Paul to their way of thinking, what did they eventually do? (Acts 21:14)

14. **Reflect:** Do you think Paul was being disobedient to the Holy Spirit? Explain your view.
15. *"After this we got ready and went up to Jerusalem."* Who accompanied the team?

16. Where did they stay upon their arrival in Jerusalem? (Acts 21:16b)
