In Christ - Colossians 2:9-15

- 8. How is that different in Christ? (Colossians 2:9)
 - Define "full / fullness."
 - What do you think Paul meant when using that word in relationship to Christ?
- 9. How has the believer been given fullness? (Colossians 2:10)
- 10. In Christ, what did Paul say about circumcision? (Colossians 2:11)
- 11. Paul explained how that inward reality was to be expressed outwardly. Using verse 12:
 - How is the Believer "buried with Christ?"
 - How is the Believer "raised with Christ?"
- 12. Using verse 13:
 - What is the spiritual condition of one who is not "in Christ?"
 - Who can change that to being alive?
 - How is that possible?
- 13. What about the role of the written code, for those who are "in Christ?" (Colossians 2:14)

- 14. What did Christ do with the powers and authorities that opposed Him? (Colossians 2:15)
- 15. **Reflect**: Look back over verses 9-15
 - What are the benefits of all those who are "in Christ?" (Colossians 12, 13)
 - How did Christ accomplish this for us? (Colossians 14, 15)

False Teaching - Colossians 2:16-23

- 16. Verse 16 begins with "therefore" referring to the previous verses. Because the Colossian Believers were "in Christ" what did Paul say they should not allow? (Colossians 2:16)
- 17. With regard to the Jewish festivals, how did Paul describe them? (Colossians 2:17a)
 - In what is the reality found? (Colossians 2:17b)
- 18. Paul warned the Colossians about allowing the false teachers to condemn them. Make a list of attributes of these false teachers. (Colossians 2:18)
- 19. What is the reality when it comes to false teachers? (Colossians 2:19)
- 20. Reflect:
 - Who is the "Head?" (Colossians 1:4, 18)
 - Think of Paul's analogy of the human body. What happens when a body part loses its connection to the mind and the muscles?
 - What do you think Paul was saying to the Colossians with that analogy?
- 21. Of what fact did Paul remind the Colossians? (Colossians 2:20a)

- What challenging question did he ask about the world's "rules?" (Colossians 2:20b)
- 22. What specific *rules*" did Paul mention? (Colossians 2:21)
- 23. All those rules were negative. What did Paul say about them? (Colossians 2:22)
- 24. Using Colossians 2:23:
 - Why are people (then and now) drawn to such regulations?
 - But, in this case, even with all these harsh restrictions and regulations what was the true reality? (Colossians 2:23b)
