Lesson 22

John was shown through vision, the events that will take place on the earth after God said, "*It is done!*" (Revelation 16:17) In the Spirit, John's vision returns to heaven as they prepare for the return of the Messiah.

Hallelujah! – Revelation 19:1 - 10

1. How did John describe the sound he heard in heaven? (vs. 1a)

2. They shouted "*Hallelujah*" meaning "*Praise Yahweh!*" What was the focus of their first praise? (vs. 1b)

3. Stop and notice - whose God did they praise?

In studying the Old Testament, we discovered that the relationship between the individuals speaking and God was revealed by how they spoke of Him. "Your" God indicated a rejection of God while "my" God indicated one who loved and followed the God of Israel. How do you refer to God? Your future destination depends upon your accepting God's gift of salvation through Jesus Christ. (John 14:6) If you are not sure you can call Him "my God" then please talk with your discussion leader, myself, your pastor or someone you know is a believer in Jesus Christ. As this study continues, you will discover that the choice one makes in this life to accept or reject Jesus will determine where one will spend eternity.

4. In addition, they praised God for His judgments. Using vs. 2:
 - How is His judgment described?

 - What was His judgment of the great prostitute?

 - What was her sin?

 - Whose blood was God avenging?

5. A second time "*Hallelujah*" is shouted because she is destroyed forever and ever. Who falls down to worship God? (vs. 4a)

This "*Hallelujah*" is followed with an "*amen*" or "*so be it*".

6. Where did the next voice come from? (vs. 5a)
7. Who did the voice say is to praise God? (vs. 5b)
8. Then all the voices rose up together. How did John describe the sound? (vs. 6a)

9. Why did they shout, "Hallelujah?" (Rev. 19:6b)
10. What was finally about to take place that brought about, "*Let us rejoice and be glad and give Him glory?*" (vs. 7b)
 - Who is ready? (vs. 7c)
11. What was she given? (vs. 8a)
12. What was the explanation of this, given in parenthesis? (vs. 8b)
13. John was instructed by the angel to write the fourth blessing described as "*the true words of God.*" What was the blessing? (vs. 9)

14. What was John's response to the angel's words? (vs. 10a)

15. What was the angel's response to John's action? (vs. 10b)

16. From whom did the angel say prophecy comes? (vs. 10c)

17. Then John saw heaven standing open and there before him was a white horse and rider.
What is the rider called? (vs. 11a)

18. What has he come to do? (vs. 11b)

19. Using vs. 12, 13:

- How did John describe the rider's eyes?
- What was on his head?
- What did John say about his name?
- How was he dressed?
- What was his name?

20. Using vs. 14:

- Who was following him?
- What were they riding?
- How were they dressed?

21. Using vs. 15:

- What came out of his mouth?
- What will that do?
- John was told he will rule with an iron scepter. How was that rule described?
- What was written on his robe and thigh? (Rev. 19:16)

The Announcement - Revelation 19:17 - 18

22. Using vs. 17, 18:

- Where did John see the next angel standing?
- What did the angel cry out to?
- What did he say to them?
- What will they be eating?
- From these two verses, what do you think John was seeing?

The War - Revelation 19:19 - 21

23. Whom did John see gathering to make war against the rider on the horse and his army? (vs. 19)

24. Using vs. 20:

- John also saw the false prophet. What had he been doing?

- What did the rider do to the beast and his false prophet?
- What happened to the rest of those who came against the rider on the horse? (vs. 21)
